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QUALIFICATION -SIT20316 Certificate II in Hospitality

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who have a defined and limited range of hospitality operational skills and basic industry knowledge. They are involved in mainly routine and repetitive tasks and work under direct supervision. This qualification provides a pathway to work in various hospitality settings, such as restaurants, hotels, motels, catering operations, clubs, pubs, cafés, and coffee shops.



ENTRY - There are no entry requirements for the qualification listed above.

Before commencing in this qualification, learner's proficiency in language, literacy and numeracy will be assessed to determine what level of support may be needed throughout the study program.



DURATION - 18 months

Students may be required to complete some theory in their own time.



This qualification is currently delivered via a combination of online and classroom-based delivery. Practical training and assessment will occur at school facilities and functions.

Assessment methods will include written, projects and observation and logbook.

It is essential that students have access to a computer with internet.

Credit transfer (CT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is available.
